DAY 1 Welcome to Washington DC. Arrive at Washington Hilton at Dupont Circle for a 3-night stay. Dinner.

DAY 2 Breakfast. Discover our nation's beautiful capital city on an all-day guided tour of Washington D.C. with stops at the WWII, Korean, Vietnam, Iwo Jima, Lincoln and FDR Memorials.
